OUR MISSION

Reuniting siblings placed in separate foster homes or out of home care, creating a lifetime of shared memories through the summer camp experience and other connection events. Sibling relationships are emotionally powerful and critically important in childhood and over the course of a lifetime. From June 16-21, 2019, Camp Twin Lakes in Warm Springs, Georgia was "home" to 80 brothers and sisters from 27 Georgia families, all with one thing in common-separation from one or more of their siblings in foster care or other out of home care. Led and encouraged by over 60 volunteers, campers experienced many traditional camp activities such as canoeing, bike riding, archery, rockwall climbing and swimming as well as specialized events and activities such as the Sibling Birthday Party, Sibling Pillows & Blankets, Life Empowerment Seminar, Scrapbooks, Carnival and Inspiration Night. Each of these events and

activities provided a unique opportunity for the siblings to spend meaningful time together. Most siblings take for granted the opportunity to share meals, play games and say goodnight each day. The kids we serve cherish these small moments they do not always have in their current home. Camp To Belong-Georgia serves every child's inherent need to know their family. The need to connect. Wednesday evening is dedicated to a camp-wide birthday party where sibling groups celebrate with individual birthday cakes and gift exchanges.
