Connecting Siblings... One Day at a Time





While there was disappointment this year over not being able to have an overnight summer camp, we were SO excited to get to see our campers in-person, for the first time in two years. And our events did not disappoint! For some of our campers, this was the first time they had been together in-person since the beginning of the pandemic. These day camps gave families a safe environment to bring their children to see their separated siblings.

Twenty-four children attended our Birthday Party Day Camps, where campers exchanged gifts with each other and sang Happy Birthday over cakes decorated with personalized names and lots of icing! Campers also had their photos taken together and they decorated frames for each other with their sibling photo. The day also included nature hikes, lunch and water balloon fun.



Two sets of separated sisters decorate frames with words and images special to them. One set of sisters wrote "Sisters by chance, friends by choice" on the back of the picture frames they made for each other with a photo from their time together at camp. These picture frames are just one way that they can keep the memories of these events alive even after they leave. The Birthday Party is a well-loved event at Summer camp. We digitalized it this year, having campers choose their sibling's gift from our online "shop," with wrapped gifts delivered to the party. Two brothers, who had participated in three virtual events between Summer of 2020 and Spring of 2021 came together at our second Day Camp this summer. During virtual events throughout the year, they often chose LEGO activities, racing in their separate locations to complete matching LEGO sets. As they came together in-person for our event, they had chosen LEGO sets for each other as birthday gifts. While other campers ran around with water balloons, these two brothers sat next to each other, tirelessly putting together their LEGO sets *together* this time.





As always, we sang happy birthday to our campers, although we did opt-out on blowing out candles on our cakes. Cakes were decorated with puzzle pieceshaped chocolates with their names written on the pieces.


