And now we also serve their families, a key component in ensuring that sibling connection happens outside of just our summer camp and events. We have added "individual" Family Connections where siblings can choose from a list of options for a personalized event.

At our August 24th event, we have sibling sets signed up with encouraging stories of connectionsome fighting life threatening illnesses, but making the commitment to spend time with a sibling. Others who went a year



without seeing each other between our 2023 and 2024 summer camps, but now attending this event--doubling the number of times they will see each other this year, with even more events to come! And another sibling who did not want to attend summer camp with his brother and sister, but will now attend a Braves game with them.
